VSS Annual Membership Meeting October 24, 2022

Meeting called to order at 6:04 PM

- Proof of Quorum was achieved with 39 members present. Attendance sheet recorded names. (attendance sheet attached below)
- Opening Remarks by Commissioner Kevin C
 - Overall, the season went well there was parity in the league with 5 out of 8 teams within 2 ½ games of each other
 - Congratulations were given to the Blue Jays for beating the Eagles 17-15 in the playoffs
 - Regular season each team played 27 or 28 games out of the scheduled 30
 - Thank you expressed to the two outgoing Board members Ken Hartwright (External competition work) & Kevin Massey (Historian and work on one-pitch tournament)
 - Fall Ball- received with positive feedback
 - 5 teams as 70 people signed up, including some new players to the league
 - Format of double-header once a week worked well; games were competitive
 - A draft format was used to create the teams
 - Each game saw 7 innings of play consistently and completed by 6pm
 - Some new rules were tested: pitching screen, no runner from home
 - Rules to be evaluated for season play by the Board
 - Holiday Party there is membership interest in a holiday party this year. Several dates were noted as possibilities Dec 3,10,17. A preliminary venue explored is Lena's in South Windsor with good food at reasonable prices. A member asked for a survey to be sent out to the membership on best date.
- Motion was made and seconded to approved the minutes from the October 25, 2021 annual league meeting. Motion passed.
- Treasurer update- Dick (report attached below)
 - The Year-end Treasurer's report for fiscal year 10/1/2021 9/30/2022 was distributed
 - Report showed FY 2021 and Dick shared some notes:
 - Sponsorships were down this season
 - Registration monies cover the core expenses to run the league; sponsorships aid with extras (new bats, balls, hats, social activities)
 - 6 new bats purchase this season for \$1302
 - Vernon Parks and Rec fee increased
 - Checking Account ending balance \$3123
 - Next major expense will be insurance in March 2023; insurance covers any injury during league play

- Picnic Wicked Slice pizza donated pizza for the league picnic
- Audit Committee Report Joe Handleman (report attached below)
 - Representatives were Joe Handleman (committee chair), Joe Marsala, Mike Lowell & Kevin Conklin
 - Process included an examination of the books and records on October 23, 2022 for activity during 10/1/2021 9/30/2022
 - Findings noted that books and records presented fairly the activity of the VSS league for the fiscal year October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022.
- External Competition report Ken
 - VSS-sponsored tournament:
 - With partnership from Kevin Massey, the second one-pitch tournament was held on Saturday August 27 at Community field
 - 4 teams participated with Talaga winning the tournament
 - Appreciation was expressed to:
 - Ed Donofrio lawn tractor usage on the field
 - Dave Hutchins tribute to Paul Frenette
 - Kari Martin- score-keeping
 - Tim Cromwell amplifier for the national anthem
 - Matt Kellie & Kevin Conklin umpires
 - A 70s team was sent to the Cape Tournament but tournament was poorly run. Rain forced cancellations and our VSS team only got to play one game on the last day. As a result this year's paid tournament fee will now be applied to next year's entry fee.
- Umpire's Report- Matt
 - Thanks were given to those who umpired this season
 - Early Spring meeting held with umpires to prepare for season
 - An umpire contact list was setup so that umpires could work directly with others when substitute coverage needed
 - During playoffs, umpires with more experience were assigned
 - Keven Busque was thanked for his help to transition role to Matt
 - Fall Ball no umpires were assigned but people just volunteered
 - Henry Park while these games were to be self-umpired, often volunteers pitched in to umpire Internal Competition Bill
 - 7 really competitive teams this season
 - 20 new players registered; it was noted that the Board did a pretty good job allocating to teams with little time to assess skills
 - 16 players used Paypal for registration
 - There were 125 active members
 - *\$7700 collected with registrations*

- Gail proposed the reduction from 30% to 25% for a quorum for any league membership meeting as attendance is challenging for these meetings. She expressed that 25% still allows sufficient representation for these meetings and conforms with other boards upon which she served. Membership seemed to support this idea and so a formal agenda item on next year's annual meeting will propose this change to the by-laws for a formal vote.
